<p>Component: Art Draw and color three types of trees using lines and shapes</p> <p>Component: Craft Create a pop out greeting card</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recapitulate previous knowledge of lines and shapes• Interpret trees as a combination of shapes and lines• Draw three types of trees:<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Conical -Pine➤ Umbrella - Coconut➤ Round – Fruit Trees• Develop awareness of examples from nature which can be categorized as three types of trees <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recognise folding as a Craft form• Develop an awareness of 3D element• Handle glue with neatness
