

Assignment 1:

Listen to any three of the following Ted Talks:

- 1) My journey from marine to actor- Adam Driver
- 2) The power of vulnerability- Brene Brown
- 3) Inside the mind of a master procrastinator- Tim Urban
- 4) Looks aren't everything. Believe me, I'm a model- Cameron Russell
- 5) Your body language may shape who you are- Amy Cuddy

For each you must:

- a- write a summary
- b- Make a list of 10 literary devices (with examples) used by the speaker
- c- Explain how you think the devices add to the talk
- d- List down at least 3 things you learned from the talk and the impact it had on you

Note: Use a separate paper for each Ted Talk. Create a cover page for each one. Staple them together to the main cover page of this assignment. Do not forget to write your name and class.

Assignment 2:

You've read and understood the first 4 scenes of Twelfth Night. Go ahead and read the 5th.

Rewrite all 5 scenes of Act 1 of Twelfth Night (use contemporary English- no need for Shakespearean). **BUT** change one of the following from the original for your new play:

- a) Character traits of any main character
- b) A significant part of the plot
- c) Setting of the play (place/time period)

Your rewrite should be a minimum of 10 pages (A4)

(Your rewrite can conclude the story in 5 scenes or not; it's up to you.)

Note: Staple the A4 papers together with the cover page of this assignment.

Submit both assignments in a pocket file with your name and class mentioned on it.

Career Workshop

Personal Portfolio: You must produce a packet or portfolio of activities. Read over all directions carefully:

1. Brainstorm: Brainstorm a list of jobs which use the skills learned in the four core academic areas. Remember to consider your preferences in these areas which might broaden your possibilities. Include at least 10 occupations for each area.

- List jobs that require the skills learned in language arts classes.
- List jobs that require the skills learned in math classes.
- List jobs that require the skills learned in science classes.
- List jobs that require the skills learned in social studies classes.

2. Is That All There Is? Brainstorm a list of four elective classes, and list at least three jobs that require the skills learned in those elective classes.

3. More Brainstorming! Now develop a list of jobs that do not require skills which could be learned in the classes you've considered for the other assignments. Think hard! How many did you come up with?

4. Career Alphabet: Think of and list at least one job or occupation for each letter of the alphabet. For some letters, you can easily think of dozens. For others, you may need to use a dictionary. The more the better!

5. Looking Ahead and Changing Times: These are two related activities. Look to the future and make a list of ten jobs that may be needed in the future, such as underwater farmers. Some contemporary jobs may still be important; but, they will have changed to reflect the times. You may include such jobs, and their changes. Also, think back to the past. Some jobs have become much less or much more important with the changing times. In the last century, blacksmiths and coopers were in demand. Make a list of ten jobs which have changed or become obsolete with new technology and demands.

6. Job Questionnaire (5 questions): Make up a job questionnaire and interview at least ten people about their jobs. Include at least ten questions in your questionnaire. Suggestions: job title, tools and equipment, special training, favorite and least favorite parts of the job.

7. I Guess We All Dream: Interview at least three adults to find out what they wanted to be when they were children. Then, interview at least three children to find out what they want to be when they grow up. Compile your information and write a paragraph for each. Use text features like bold letters for headings and italics for important quotes.

8. Recipe for my Career: Write a symbolic recipe for your chosen career or the career you have are thinking to take up. You should include the 'ingredients' like education, training, character traits, etc. and the 'method' just like a recipe for food. At the end you can write a note about the positive aspects of your career.

9. Famous People: Research any three famous people who share the same career as the one you have thought to pursue. Write about some of their major accomplishments.

10. 21st Century Skills: Research the 21st Century Skills that are necessary for success in today's world. Write a paragraph about any six. Can these skills be learnt from text books? Why or why not?

11. Design a Cover: Prepare an interesting design for the cover of your portfolio, including a title related to careers. On the other side of the cover, prepare an index of all the above tasks and staple them together. Number each page and mention the task number and page number.

Note: Marks will be awarded for creativity and Language proficiency. Remember to write your name and class.

ACTIVITY # 2:

You want to start a business of selling chips in cylindrical cans. In starting you need 100 cans. You may take the sizes of the cylindrical cans of chips already sold in the market (Pringles). How much paper is required to cover the outside of your cylindrical can?

Hint: You can use string to measure the dimensions of cylinder.

ACTIVITY # 3:

You are required to draw a frequency table of the number of the children in your neighborhoods. Collect the data for six houses. After collecting the data in the frequency table find the mean, median and mode of the data.

ACTIVITY # 4:

Draw a sample space of different colors of your clothes. From the sample space find the probability of selecting different colors of clothes. You may find the probability of wearing at least five different colors of clothes.

ACTIVITY # 5:

Your father wants to buy a house for which you have taken a loan of Rs. 5000000 from a bank for a period of 10 years. The bank charges a total of 23% simple interest per annum. How much amounts your father has returned, also find the monthly installment. If another bank charges 15% compound interest compounded annually. How much your father has to pay back and what will be monthly installment. Which is a better to choose?
