

Assignment 1:

Research on the Elizabethan Era:

Note: Make sure you can find **at least** three sources before you start writing. You must use **two electronic sources** and **one other source** you can find. (IE: Magazines, books, newspaper articles, encyclopedias, etc.) Mention the sites and other the names of the sources you refer to at the bottom of your A4 sheets. Label each task accurately and staple it to your cover page (which you can design and decorate). Do not forget to write your name and class.

1. Queen Elizabeth's Family Tree (Draw)
2. Queen Elizabeth and her reign over England (What kind of a queen was she?)
3. Four famous writers of the Elizabethan Era (with a mini- biography of each and a list of five of their famous books)
4. Elizabethan Fashion for Men and Women (by social class)
5. Education during the Elizabethan Era
6. Elizabethan foods and culinary practices
7. Health and Medicine of the Elizabethan Era
8. Tudor Architecture and Furniture
9. The law in Elizabethan England (enforcements, courts, and justice)
10. Music and Musical Instruments

12. Shakespeare's career in theater (his work and influence)

Assignment:

Reviewing a Video Game

We have all played video games at some time or the other. Choose one video game (whether it is played on a Play Station, iPad or Smart Phone). You have to review the video game according to the following tasks. Each task must be done on a separate A4 sized paper. Staple them all together to the cover page and make an index on the inside page of the cover. Do not forget to write your name and class.

- A. Synopsis: Brief overview of the game (the challenges/ goals/ levels)
- B. Audience: The age group that the game mostly appeals to and why. (Find out statistics from the internet.)
- C. Gameplay: What is the purpose of the game? What is the story line? What genre does it belong to? From whose point of view is the game played? Mention two more games of the same genre.
- D. Graphics: What is the quality of the graphics? How are colours? What is the setting of the game like?
- E. Sound Effects: Does the game have a musical score? What are the ambient (background) sound like? Use descriptive wordings.
- F. Replay Value: Give your opinion. Do you think this game will be popular for years to come? Why or why not? Make a list of pros and cons. Use persuasive writing.
- G. Interview: Ask anyone who play the game ten informative and interesting questions about it and write it in a dialogue format.
- H. Research: Find out at least two more reviews and write them out from the internet about this game. Cite the internet sites at the bottom of the page for both.
- I. Cover Page: Finally design a cover page that should be an 'Advert' for the game. Mention the designer of the game and its date of release along with other features of a good advert you have studied.

You shall be awarded marks for creativity, accuracy of grammar and use of interesting vocabulary.

Research and find out what minerals are found in your jewellery. It could have pearls, gold, diamond, silver or quartz.


