<b>Component: Craft</b> Greeting Cards with 3D paper effect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Design a greeting card for a purpose.</li><li>• Explore creative expression.</li><li>• Focus on concepts of:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ symmetry</li><li>➤ borders</li><li>➤ folding</li><li>➤ pasting</li></ul></li></ul>

<b>Component: Art</b> Shading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Develop awareness of pencil drawing.</li><li>• Develop an understanding of shading as an art form.</li><li>• Develop awareness for smudge techniques.</li><li>• Identify the concept of toning and shading in pencil shading.</li></ul>
