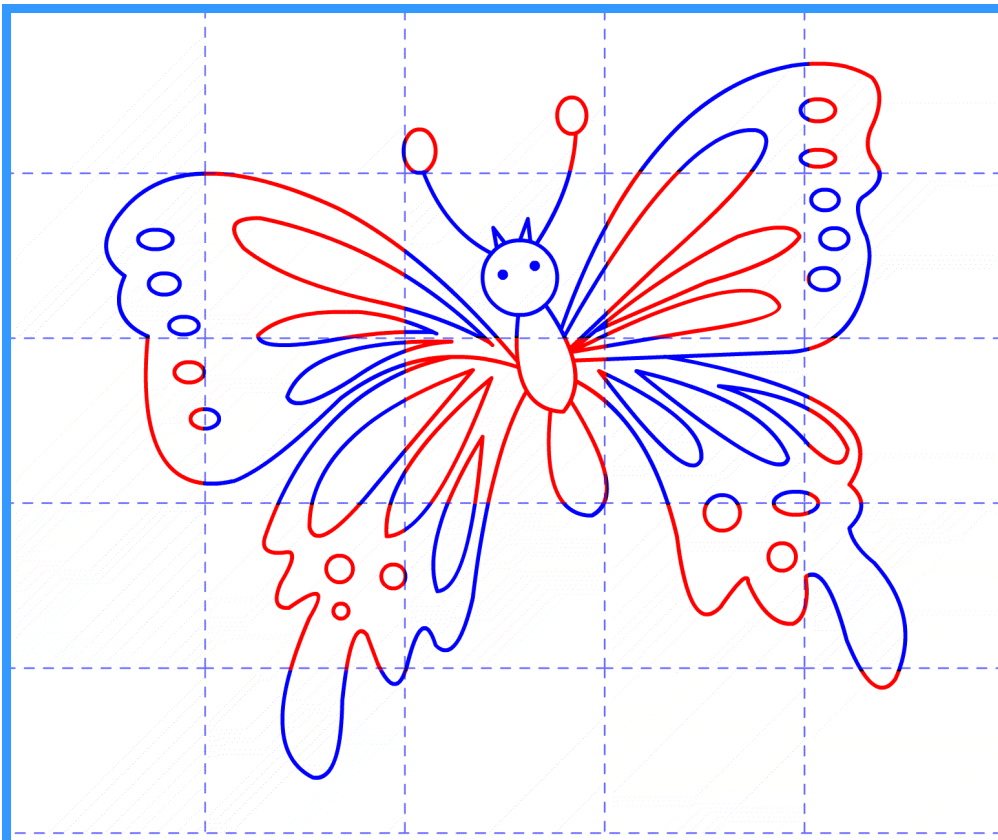

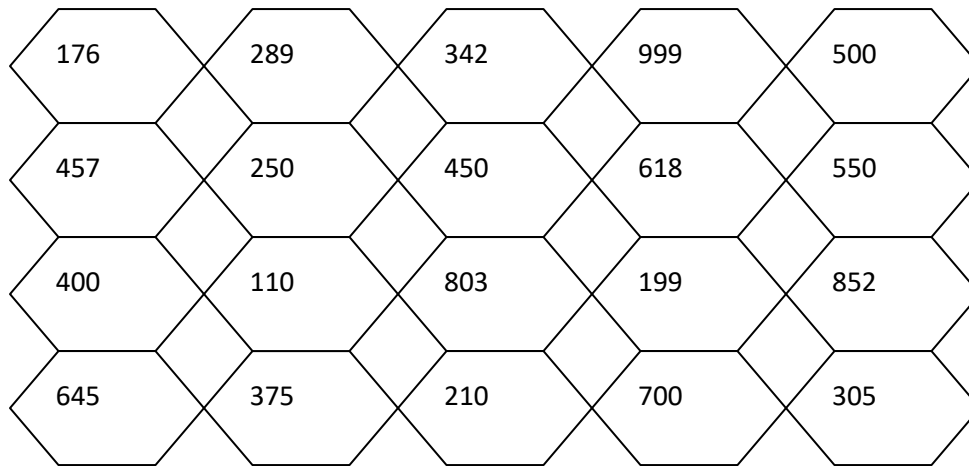

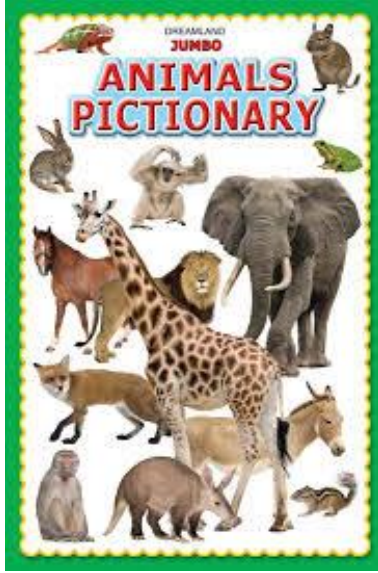
General knowledge:**Task 1:**
