Write 5 pages of neat handwriting from your favorite story book. This will help to improve your handwriting. This must be done in a thin four lined copy.



# What You Do:

- 2. Now, offer her some magazines to look through for finding different season's scenes. When she finds an image she likes, she can tear out the page to use for later.
- 3. Once she has a stack of pictures to work from, she can begin cutting out images from the magazine pages.
- 4. A collage is a collection of images arranged in a free form or organized manner.
- 5. When she's ready, she can glue the season's images on her paper. Remember to help her print out her poem or paragraph to include in the finished creation!
