Science:

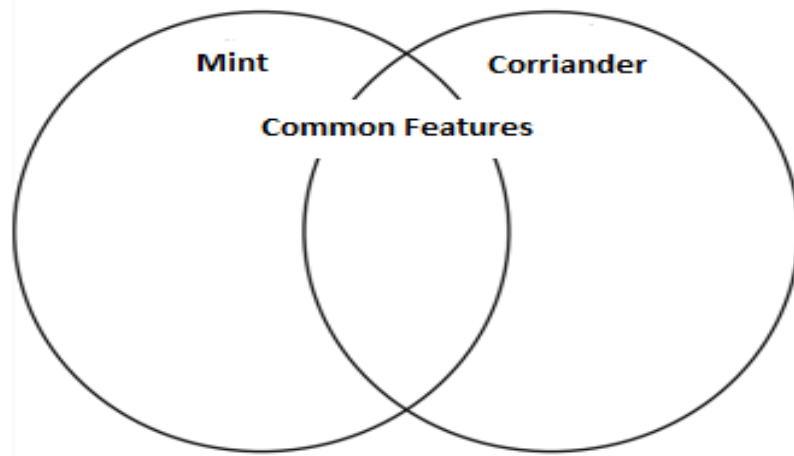
Find out the differences and similarities between the leaves of mint and coriander.
